

THE TREK STOP FACT SHEET

FACILITIES

The Trek Stop includes facilities on site for guests to enjoy their stay while surrounded by the rain forest.

- Cabins ranging in sizes from regular, medium, large, to the special Honeymoon Jungle Suite. The regular cabins house 1 to 2 people, medium: 1-3 people, large: 1-4, and Jungle Suite: 1-3.
- Dining area to sit and enjoy nature while enjoying a homemade meal prepared with guests in mind.
- Swimming pool with surrounding deck for visitors to cool down from Belize's heat or soak it up.
- Tropical Wings Nature Center offers guests the chance to learn and experience first hand the butterflies indigenous to Belize.

ADVENTURE INCLUDED

Located in the Cayo district, The Trek Stop provides access to tourist attractions around Western Belize.

- **Xuantunich:** An ancient Mayan ruin site, which features plenty of sites to explore, including the second tallest structure in Belize, El Castillo. This temple stands 130 feet tall and visitors can climb all the way to the top and look out on the Guatemalan and Belize border.
- **San Jose Succotz:** A local village which features small restaurants and shops to give travelers an authentic taste of the country they are visiting.
- **San Ignacio:** A urban town further away from the Succotz village, but presents a faster, change of pace. Travelers can experience a variety of restaurants, coffee shops, markets, and more to get a sense of urban life.
- **Mopan River:** A nearby river where locals go to spend time with family and enjoy the outdoors. Travelers can participate in this community experience by swimming, tubing, or kayaking/canoing on the Mopan.
